### All You Need to Know...

Girls in the Daddy/Daughter dance will need a white dress, and the dads will need dark dress slacks, white button down shirt, dark shoes and socks. Since it can sometimes be frustrating to locate a white dress, we will have some options available for you to order upon request.

#### Please read the following information very carefully before committing to the Daddy/Daughter Dance 2018

- 1. The non-refundable fee to participate is \$85 (includes all rehearsals, dress rehearsal and access to the online video choreography tutorial!) and will be deducted automatically from your tuition account. This fee is non-refundable, so moms, make sure the dad actually knows about the dance, rehearsal dates and times and is fully committed before signing up. Dancers must be 3 years of age by January 1, 2018 in order to participate.
- 2. The Daddy/Daughter dance is great fun but it also involves lifting your daughter, basic choreography and several hours of rehearsals. If you have back problems or other physical conditions that prohibit you from lifting the weight of your daughter or kneeling, please contact us before you sign up for the Daddy/Daughter dance.
- 3. There are 6 rehearsals:

CLT & KAN: Saturday, January 27, Saturday, February 24, Saturday, March 10, Saturday, April 21 & Saturday, May 19

KPAC: Dress Rehearsal Friday, June 1st MANDATORY

4. We make every effort to adhere to the rehearsal schedule. However, this is "showbiz" and circumstances beyond our control sometimes cause schedule changes. If the schedule is adjusted, we will provide at least 24-hours notice.

- 5. We will communicate with Daddy/Daughter participants via email only. If you do not have email or if you never check your email, please do not register for the Daddy/Daughter dance.
- 6. The Daddy/Daughter dance is an experience that will last a lifetime. Sharing rehearsal time and working through difficult choreography with your daughter will be as memorable as the actual performance itself!
- 7. All rehearsals are "Closed Rehearsals", meaning Moms, friends and family may not watch the daddy daughter rehearsals.
- 8. Dads must know and memorize the following information in order to be placed in the correct cast. This information will be given to you on or before your first rehearsal:
- a. What recital is your daughter in?
- b. What day is the recital?
- c. What date is the recital?
- d. What time is the recital?
- e. Where is the recital (physical location)?
- f. What is the name of the dance that your daughter is performing in her regular weekly class?
- 9. The Daddy/Daughter Dance will be the last number of each recital. Daddy/Daughter couples will only perform once. In the event your daughter is required to perform in multiple recitals due to class schedule, we will contact you and assign a specific performance for their Daddy/Daughter Dance. If there are siblings wanting to perform with their dad, please complete one form per child, and we will contact you with more details.
- 10. We realize that many dads travel out of town on business; however, rehearsal attendance is very important. We kindly ask that you not miss the last "In Studio" rehearsal as this is when stage placements are assigned, and please remember that the dress rehearsal is mandatory. Unfortunately, we are unable to alter the rehearsal schedule to accommodate individual travel plans, illness, vacation etc.
